Our Centenary is approaching.....

At the recent District Forum, I talked through some of the ideas we have for the Centenary Celebrations. I hope to finalise the calendar at the next GSLs Meeting on Wednesday 8th June which is a joint session with the District Team. I am keen to have a memorable year *without* adding to the burden of the leaders. To give you a taster, here are some of the ideas:

- We will kickoff the Celebrations with a **Sunrise Event** in September. The idea is to camp somewhere then get up really early, see the sunrise, have a good breakfast and go home!
- **Themes** – each month we have suggested a decade that you can use to inspire your weekly programme. So, for example, February is the 1960's. A quick search provides this link with some good inspiration: <http://history1900s.about.com/od/timelines/tp/1960timeline.htm>
- In October, we will be walking the length of District. The initial idea was based on “**Beating the Bounds**” but it might turn into more of a relay. Think “Olympic Torch” but walking and with the District Flag and the Band will be involved somewhere
- In November and March we will be holding a “**Host another Unit**” Event. You will get to host another Unit and then visit another Unit. All Sections will take part and it will be quite competitive to see who holds the best night!
- In December, there will be “Christmas on the Edge”
- **Camps and Sleepovers.** We discussed having a District Camp but it is a lot of organisation for one weekend. The current proposal is as follows:
 - Beavers: Centenary Sleepover. We are investigating a number of options for location but any other ideas would be good

- Scouts and Explorers. The Big Camp: <http://www.thebigcamp.net/> A big camp hosted by West Yorkshire Scouts at the Great Yorkshire Showground near Harrogate
- Leaders: 2012 Gilwell Reunion. First Weekend in September at the home of Scouting, Gilwell Park.
- Leaders Events
 - **Chilli Bakeoff**: A family event to see who can cook the best chilli con carne. Open to leaders, parents, Scouts, Explorers and the DC. Independent judges will be found so that I can win fairly!
 - In February, there will be a **Dinner Dance** for Leaders, Parents and Supporters
- We will finish the Celebrations with a **Sunset Event** in September. Campfire, Food and Fireworks have been mentioned!
- One important aspect we have yet to work out is **Service**. We want to do something for other people. A number of ideas have been discussed such as equipping a Scout Group in Africa. Ideas welcome.
- **Golden Mile** – This is a scheme that encourages fitness and also provides an opportunity to fundraise with only little bit of effort from the leaders. More details at your next Group Leaders meeting
- We will have a **Centenary Badge** that all members will wear for the year and a Centenary T-shirt has been proposed.

It's looking like an exciting year but as with all things, it will only happen if everyone does a little bit to help.
