Cheshire Challenge

Date for your Diary: Launch Meeting at 2pm, Sunday 20th November 2011 at Handforth Scout HQ

After the successful launch of the Cheshire Challenge a couple of years ago, It's back for 2012. The Badge is made up of three parts; Bronze, Silver and Gold. We would expect that Groups would be able to award the Bronze section around Easter time, the Silver section before the summer break and the Gold section at Christmas.

The badge sections should be awarded to all those who actively took part in the Challenge in the section during the year. A record card is included to assist you.

Position of the Badge: The original proposal was that the badge would be worn on the right hand side of the shirt/jumper but that's being rethought as with the smaller members they would run out of space quite quickly. I will advice you once the decision has been made.

Ordering the Badge: The three badges come as a set and are ordered through the District. Your initial order needs to be in by Friday 18 November and they will be available for distribution in January. There will an opportunity to place a further order in May 2012 for distribution at the end of June.

Awarding the Badges: The bronze badge must not be worn before Friday 30 March 2012, the silver badge must not be worn before Friday 1 June 2012 and the gold badge must not be worn before Friday 23 November 2012. All the badges achieved can be worn until 31 December 2013. Badges should be presented as each individual achieves the required points for each award, please don't wait until all three have been achieved before presenting the badges.

Moving Sections: A key point of this initiative is to encourage "moving on' between sections therefore if a Beaver gains the bronze award when they move into Cubs the silver and gold badges should go with them to Cubs where the expectation is that they will achieve the silver and gold award.

Adults and Cheshire Challenge: All adults are encouraged to participate in activities and events to gain the Cheshire Challenge badges.

Alderley Launch: Copies of the booklet will be distributed at the Launch Meeting at 2pm on 20th November 2011 at Handforth Scout HQ. If you don't have yours, contact your Group (Groups can get copies from me). We are currently reviewing the Centenary Programme to align it with the Cheshire Challenge – at the launch we will have advice on how you can use the Centenary Activities as part of the Challenge.

One last thing, in Alderley we don't generally like local rules but I am making one exception – the Band counts as a Section. If you do an activity with Simon, Emma and the team, they count as a Section!
